SPOT LIGHT ON GOVERNMENT CONTRACTORS

There is a reciprocal expectation on Government contractors, who receive business and are paid from tax money, to be faithful in complying with their tax obligations. Those who fail their tax obligations can be in deep trouble.

A company involved in providing services to Covid-19 operations at the National Control Centre was flagged for its non-compliance. Through the audit, it was discovered that the company failed to file and pay any taxes since its establishment, despite receiving payments from certain government departments during that period. An assessment was raised, with the company's bank accounts subsequently garnisheed and the company ended up paying more than K180,000 to IRC.
